

## Bronze Beauty Ajuga (*Ajuga reptans* 'Bronze Beauty')

Bronze Beauty Ajuga has glossy, bronze-purple foliage. Spreads by stolons with vigor. Blooms lilac-blue on 2"-3" tall flower spikes putting on a brilliant show in



Spring.

**Plant Care and Maintenance:** Plants can be mowed on high to remove spent flowers. Ajuga thrives in humusy soil and will grow fine in average, well drained soil. Will tolerate occasional dry soil but prefers regular watering. Plant in areas with good air circulation in hot, humid climates to prevent crown rot. Good for large areas as ground cover, on slopes and edges of pathways as well as rock gardens and beds. Careful using it near grass edges where it may invade the lawn. Mature height 3"-4", spread 18"-24" . Water when soil dries out.
