Mongolian Aster

(Asteromea mongolica)

The Mongolian aster is like baby's breath but is easier to grow and lasts longer. The Mongolian aster is a perennial that grows to 2-3 feet high, and blooms appear in late summer and fall.



Plant Care: The Mongolian aster grows easily in most climates – Vermont to Georgia and New Jersey to California. These double white flowers are deer-resistant and drought-tolerant.

Watering: Mongolian asters may need water about 2 times each week.
