

Salmon Canna Lily

(*Canna x generalis*)

This salmon-colored canna lily is a tropical perennial as grown in USDA Zones 7-11. Also called Canna Lily and Indian Shot, this perennial flower can grow up to 24-30 inches tall and gives a wonderful display with its colorful foliage and blooms of intense salmon colors. Flowers bloom from summer until first frost in fall.



Plant Care: Canna Salmon grows best in full sun to partial shade. This plant does well growing in containers, near ponds, pools and along a water's edges, and is best planted in masses in perennial borders and flower beds. Deadheading the old blooms helps encourage new flower buds and can tidy up the plant's appearance late in the season.

Watering: Keep the plant watered during dry weather to ensure strong growth. Canna Lily will naturalize and spread in the garden, so be sure to divide in the fall and give to friends!
