Cassian's Fountain Grass

(Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian')

Fountain grass is a warm season ornamental grass which typically grows in graceful, spreading clumps from 2-3' tall and as wide. It features narrow, green leaves in summer, changing to golden yellow in fall and brown in late fall/winter. Showy, slivery, bristly bottle brush like flower spikes arch outward from the clump in late summer, like water spraying from a fountain.



Plant Care: Easily grown in average, medium to wet soil in full or partial shade. Does best in full sun. It has no serious insect or disease problems. Cut back the brown foliage in late winter, early spring before new growth occurs emerges for a clean start and a fresh-looking plant.

Watering: Fountain grass grows best in evenly moist soil.
