Great Expectations Hosta

(Hosta 'Great Expectations')

Great Expectations is a Hosta cultivar that features a 22-24" tall mound of large, variegated, oval leaves with creamy white centers with wide, blue green edges. The mound will typically spread to 30-33". Long shoots of flowers will appear in summer.

Hummingbirds may be attracted to the flowers.



Plant Care: Hostas are herbaceous perennial plants meaning the foliage will die back in the late fall. It will start to reappear in early spring. It prefers part shade to full shade. It will not perform well in sun. It is relatively pest free.

Watering: Hostas grow best in evenly moist well drained soil. Established plants can tolerate dry shade but will do best with consistent moisture.
