Snow White Indian Hawthorn

(Rhaphiolepis indica)

Fresh, white spring blooms with rich evergreen foliage - the Snow White Indian Hawthorn is perfect for year-round visual interest. It typically grows to 4-6 feet tall and as wide. Whether you plant it as a hedge, a single focal specimen or accent among your other garden favorites, its glossy leaves make a statement. Plus, purplish black berries emerge in early autumn, attracting a wildlife show making the Snow White Indian Hawthorn a true season-to-season must have.



Plant Care / Watering: Plant in well drained, average soil and water regularly until established. Continue watering weekly or more during periods of extreme heat. Fertilize in early spring before new growth appears.
