

Wheeler's Dwarf Japanese Pittosporum (*Pittosporum tobira* 'Wheeler's Dwarf')

This dwarf, rounded shrub is perfect as a low border, ground cover or container specimen. It is prized for its dense, compact growth and glossy evergreen foliage. It occasionally produces small orange blossom-scented flowers and requires little maintenance.



Plant Care: This evergreen shrub requires partial to full sun, grows at a moderate rate, and reaches 2 to 3 feet tall and 4 to 5 feet wide. White, fragrant flowers bloom in the spring.

It may be planted singly or in small groups. Its short stature makes an ideal foundation planting under windows. With its spreading, dense foliage, it is also a great ground cover or filler beneath tree canopies, or between taller shrubs.

Watering: Water regularly - weekly, or more often in extreme heat or containers.
