

Viburnum, Moonlit Lace (Viburnum hybrid 'sPg-3-024)

Rounded flower heads rise above glossy, evergreen foliage on burgundy-colored stems. This fast-growing plant develops pink buds that give way to beautiful, white blooms in the spring. The foliage gains a burgundy color in the fall. This robust plant is drought tolerant and deer resistant. It will grow in full sun or part shade. This plant is disease and pest resistant. The mature plant grows to about 4 feet. Its compact habit and rounded shape is great for use as a border or a hedge in mass plantings.



Plant care / watering: Water regularly for the first year after planting. Once established, water only when the soil becomes dry. This plant should never have more than 1 inch of water dampening the soil. Moonlit Lace grows best in well drained slightly acidic soil. This plant is not a heavy feeder but you can apply fertilizer to it for better growth. This plant may be pruned to remove dead wood and keep its shape. Prune in the late winter or before the flowering season.
